

Should Los Angeles Give Sanctuary To Gang Members?

If a known gang member is in our country illegally, should we deport him before we catch him murdering one of our children, or should we instead wait until afterwards?

Ask the parents of Jamiel Shaw, II, a high school football star, headed for college, who was murdered in March 2008 *just three doors down from his own home*. The man charged with murdering Jamiel was an illegal alien gang member who could have been, and should have been, deported *years earlier*.

If that gang member had been deported, Jamiel would be finishing his senior year at L.A. High School, and would be headed to college. Instead, Jamiel is dead, his family is shattered, and his nine-year-old brother wonders if the gangs are going to kill him, too.

But Mayor Villaraigosa and the City Council insist on granting "sanctuary city" protection not just to illegal aliens who come here to work, but also to illegal aliens who come here to kill.
